How does the application process work?

It's best to apply electronically so that we can access your documents without any delays but naturally you are welcome to submit documents in paper form.

What documents must be included in the application?

In addition to a covering letter showing your motivation for joining 29Forward, please send us your CV and evidence of all previous activities and training since leaving school. Your availability and salary expectations should also be included.

In which formats can my attachments be sent?

All common file formats are readable, but we prefer PDF. File attachments should not exceed a total size of 5 MB.

What is the further application procedure?

After receiving your documents, we will check them and contact you as soon as possible. If we believe that you are a good fit for 29FORWARD, we will schedule an initial meeting with your supervisor so that he can introduce you to 29FORWARD, our clients and projects, and you can tell him about your background, your experience and your motivation. If everything fits, a second interview will take place in an equally relaxed atmosphere but now with a few future colleagues.

How should I prepare for my interview?

Best not at all. Seriously, come as you are. We prefer authenticity to memorised phrases.

Will my application be treated confidentially?

It goes without saying. Your documents will be handled with absolute confidentiality.

Are travel expenses to job interviews reimbursed?

Can I write my thesis at 29FORWARD?

You bet. If your topic includes BI, banking or specific topics such as SAS or statistical areas, we'd love to hear your idea.

How long do customer projects take on average?

Since projects and customer requirements differ greatly, this cannot be said in general. Even with an average value, there are no guarantees that it will apply to you.

How long do travel activities take on average?

With increasing seniority, the proportion on site grows. But as a rule, we are on site with the customer for four days per week. However, your time can be flexibly arranged, so that Fridays without work are also possible.

Do I have to change my place of residence for work?

In principle, any place of residence is suitable as a base for projects. However, it is up to you to decide whether it would be worthwhile for you to move to our location.

Can I also gain international experience in another office?

If your skillset matches the current project workload, you are welcome to gain international experience.
